

## SUE IS SIXTY

A 32 bar jig for three couples.

A and I Jamieson

### Bars

- 1 - 8 1<sup>st</sup> man casts off and, followed by his partner, dances below 3<sup>rd</sup> man, across the set and up behind 3<sup>rd</sup> lady. 1<sup>st</sup> man then crosses to 2<sup>nd</sup> place on his own side and faces down while 1<sup>st</sup> lady dances into 2<sup>nd</sup> place on her own side and faces up. 2<sup>nd</sup> couple step up on bars 5 and 6.
- 9 – 12 All three couples dance anti clockwise half way round (to end 3,1,2, on opposite sides.)
- 13 – 16 All dance set and link into lines across.
- 17 – 20 All half turn the person opposite and cast (twirl) to the other person's place.
- 21 – 24 All dance set and link into side lines. (Now 3.1.2. with 1<sup>st</sup> couple on opposite side).
- 25 – 28 1<sup>st</sup> man dances down between 2<sup>nd</sup> couple and casts up round 2<sup>nd</sup> man to 2<sup>nd</sup> place on own side while 1<sup>st</sup> lady dances up between 3<sup>rd</sup> couple and casts off round 2<sup>nd</sup> lady to 2<sup>nd</sup> place on own side.
- 29 – 32 1<sup>st</sup> couple turn right hand once round. (or birl as many times as is possible in four bars)

*Birthday dance for Sue Petyt. The clue to the birthday is in the track of 1M in the first 12 bars*

## Crib

- 1-8** *1M, followed by partner casts 2 places, across set, around 3W and into 2<sup>nd</sup> place on own sides*
- 9-16** *All chase 1/2 way anti-clockwise. All set & link*
- 17-24** *All 1/2 turn facing person and 'twirl to their place. All set & link*
- 25-32** *1's dance 1/2 fig of 8 (M down, W up). 1's turn RH*
